Rules & Guidelines

- Participants can participate individually in Elocution. Maximum two participants/students (16 to 35 years of age as on 01.03.2020) are allowed from one University/Institute/College/Centre to participate in the elocution competition.
- Nomination/registration must reach to the Institute on or before 11th March, 2020 in writing from the University/Institute/College/Center forwarded by the Head of the Institute/Dept.
- Once registered replacement of any participant is not allowed after 11th March 2020.
- The speech shall be (4+1) and may not exceed 5 minutes' duration. The time limit will be strictly enforced. A warning bell will be given at 4 mins.
- The speaker is expected to memorize their speech, and is not allowed to read and take references from written notes during the speech. Use of electronic gadget in any form is prohibited for the speech. Any individual using unfair means will be disqualified.

Points will be awarded based on the following criteria:

A. Content

- Introduction.
- Knowledge of subject matter.
- Exposition of the main theme (Conciseness & Clarity of message, Originality/Points of interest, Incorporation of Personal references, Quotations & Biblical References).
- Moral & Practical Application.
- Conclusion.

B. Communication & Presentation Skills

- Memorization (evaluated by pauses).
- Verbal Clarity (pronunciation of words, voice strength and projection).
- Body language, voice modulation & audience connect to keep them engage.
- Knowledge of subject matter.

***Decision of the judges shall be final.**

For Elocution competition, the prize money for 1st and 2nd will be Rs.25,000 & 15,000 respectively.
