SUBJECT: CHANGE IN TOTAL NUMBER OF SEATS, ADMISSION PROCEDURE AND GUIDELINES FOR DIPLOMA IN YOGA SCIENCE FOR GRADUATES OF ONE YEAR DURATION.

1. MDNIY is conducting Diploma in Yoga Science (DYSc) for graduates of one year duration with an intake capacity of 120 seats (GM-60, OBC 33, SC-18 and ST-09) + 12 seats reserved for A&N and Lakshadweep Islands (2 seats); North-East States (2 seats); Sports Person/NCC/NSS (2 seats); War Martyrs (2 seats); Foreign students (2 seats); J&K state (1 seat); and Children of MDNIY employees (1 seat) and the total seats come to 132, for the last 9-10 years. The reservation of seats is applicable as per Govt. policy in respect of SC/ST/OBC issued from time to time. A copy of the existing Admission Brochure of DYSc for the Academic year 2018-19 is enclosed as **Annexure-A.**

2. With the introduction of new Courses affiliated by the Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University (GGSIPU) i.e. B.Sc.(Yoga), M.Sc.(Yoga) & PGDYT, there is shortage of space and accommodation in the premises of MDNIY. Therefore, it is desired to decrease the seat intake capacity of the DYSc from 120 seats to 60 seats and the reservation of seats is applicable as per Govt. policy in respect of SC/ST/OBC & EWS (EWS is newly inducted by Govt. of India) issued from time to time.

3. Further, Ministry of HRD vide its OM No.12-4/2019-U1 dated 17th January, 2019 has introduced providing reservation to Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservations for SC, ST and Socially and educationally backward classes to the tune of 10% of the total seats in each category and that the seats increase would be to the tune of 25% more seats. Therefore, the seat matrix for an intake of proposed 60 seats will come to 75 as detailed hereunder. A Copy of GGSIPU letter dated 5.4.2019 in this regard is enclosed as **Annexure-B:**

- Andaman & Nicobar and Lakshadweep Islands	02
- North East States	02
- Sports Person/NCC/NSS	02
- Dependents of War Martyrs/Ex-servicemen	02
- J&K State	01
- Children of MDNIY employees	01
- Persons with Disability (5%)	03*
- Foreign students (15%)	09

*The students with disability will be given relaxation in age for 5 years as per Section 32A of the Right to Persons with Disability Act.

5. It is also proposed to introduce Best Student Awards (First, Second and Third position of the denomination of Rs.25,000/-, Rs.15,000/- and Rs.10,000/-) to the best three students of DYSc instead of providing Hostel stipend and the Cash Prizes. The selection of the students for such Awards will be made by a Committee constituted of Senior Faculty and officers of the Institute and on the terms and conditions set forth. This has been approved by the SFC in its 39th meeting held on 22.4.2019 vide Agenda Item Nos.1- & 15 (copy of minutes of the 39th SFC meeting is enclosed herewith as **Annexure-4**).

6. **Fee structure:** The existing fee structure for the DYSc was adopted in the academic year 2017-18 as given in **Table-I** below. In view of the cost escalation, it is proposed to revise the fee structure for Indians and foreigners separately w.e.f. academic session 2019-20 and onwards, as per **Table-II**:

6. **Fellowship:** A fellowship of Rs.8,000/- (Rupees eight thousand only) per month will be awarded to the following students (max for 10 months in a year)

(a) Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep – 2 students

(b) North-east states – 2 students

The terms and conditions of the fellowship will be:

(i) Candidature of the above students has to be recommended and forwarded by the Health/AYUSH Deptt. of the concerned State/UT

(ii) Award of the fellowship to such students is also subject to their regularity, requisite attendance (80% besides 5% on medical ground only on production of Medical certificate by competent authority OR 5% at the discretion of the Director on valid reasons to be recorded) and discipline. The students granted fellowship will have to execute a Bond in the prescribed format in this regard.

7. It is desired to change the selection procedure from the existing merit-cum-reservation to the conducting of the Entrance Examination and the candidates securing 40% or more marks in the Entrance Examination (for General/OBC/EWS category and 35% or above marks for SC/ST/PwD) will be considered for admission on merit. There may be 06 centres to conduct the Entrance Examination, namely, Delhi, Bangalore, Chennai, Kolkata, Mumbai, Bhopal and no T.A/D.A will be payable to candidate appearing in the Entrance Exam at any of the centre. Further the candidates from foreign countries need not to appear in the Entrance Exam and their selection for D.Y.Sc. will be as per the marks obtained in Graduation, on merit.


8. It is also to inform that in case of two or more candidates, securing equal percentage of marks at the bottom of the select list, preference will be given to that candidate who is possessing degree/s in any Yoga /Indian System of Medicine / Philosophy / Physiotherapy / Physiology / Diet and Nutrition/ Psychology /Sanskrit/ respectively. In case of none, the percentage of marks obtained in Graduation Exam will be the next criteria of selection.


9. The matter seeking approval for the changes in the seats, admission procedure, etc. of the Diploma in Yoga Science for Graduates of one year duration, was placed vide Agenda Item No.15 before the 39th meeting of the SFC held on 22nd April, 2019. **The SFC discussed the matter and directed to submit a separate proposal for examination and approval of the Ministry.** Accordingly, the proposal is being sent to the Ministry for its consideration and examination.

It is, therefore, requested to kindly consider and convey the approval of the competent authority to the following modifications in the DYSc from the academic year 2019-20 and onwards:

1. To change the seat intake capacity of the DYSc from 120 seats to 60 seats with reservation of seats as per Govt. policy;
2. To introduce providing reservation to Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservations for SC, ST and Socially and educationally backward classes to the tune of 10% of the total seats in each category and that the seats increase would be to the tune of 25% more seats, making the total seats intake as 75 and also 22 special category seats as proposed;
3. To introduce Best Student Awards (First, Second and Third position of the denomination of Rs.25,000/-, Rs.15,000/- and Rs.10,000/-) to the best three student of DYSc instead of providing Hostel stipend and the Cash Prizes;
4. To revision of the fee structure as proposed;
5. To grant fellowship of Rs.8,000/- (Rupees eight thousand only) to the two students from Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep and two students from North East States (max. for 10 months in a year)

6. To introduce the Entrance Examination in place of existing merit-cum-reservation for admission to DYSc and the candidates securing 40% or more marks in the Entrance Examination (for General/OBC/EWS category and 35% or above marks for SC/ST/PwD) will be considered for admission on merit.
7. To conduct entrance examination at 06 centres namely, Delhi, Bangalore, Chennai, Kolkata, Mumbai, Bhopal for Indian students; and foreign students may be exempted from appearing the Entrance Exam and the criteria of their selection may be the marks obtained in Graduation, on merit.

Sub: Change in total number of seats, admission procedure and guidelines for Diploma in Yoga Science for graduates of one year duration – reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the your U.O. Note No.61/58/2019-20/YE/MDNIY/DYSc/Admission dated 01.08.2019 on the above mentioned subject and to convey the approval of the competent authority to the following proposals submitted by MDNIY:-

- i. The intake capacity of 120 + 12 special category seats (A&N and Lakshadweep Island-02; North East State-02; J&K State-01; Sports/NCC/NSS-02; War Martyrs-02; Foreign students-02; MDNIY Staff quota-01), as approved by the SFC/GC, have been reduced from 120 to 60. The new Courses of M.Sc. (Yoga) and PGDYT in affiliation with Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University are to be introduced during the current academic year.
- ii. With the introduction of the 10% reservation of EWS (Economically Weaker Sections) as per the Govt. of India norms, the 60 seats, as proposed, have been increased to 75 because of the reservation is to be provided to the total seats earmarked in each category (SC,ST, OBC & Gen.) increasing the total seats by 25%.

The seats for foreigners have been increased to 15% of the intake capacity keeping in view of the interest shown by the foreigners, which comes to 09. 5% seats are required to be reserved for disabled persons as per the disability act, which comes to 03 seats. Therefore, total seats in all the special category comes to 22.

- iv. In view of the cost escalation the fees has been marginally increased by Rs.2,000/- from Rs.10,000/- which was being charged as tuition fees w.e.f. 2017-18. For SC/ST/EWS categories, relaxation of 50% of fees is to be given. The fee for foreigners has been increased proportionately and the ratio of fees proposed for foreigners is 1:5.
- v. The mode of selection has been changed from merit-cum-reservation at all India basis of qualifying examination to the Entrance Examination with the cut off percentage of 40% for General and 35% for SC/ST/EWS categories.
- vi. The proposal of MDNIY to do away with and withdraw Cash Prizes and Hostel Stipend earlier being paid to the students to the tune of Rs.16.20 lakh per annum and instead proposed the Best Students Award to the tune of Rs.50,000/- per annum has also been approved.
